## **Project Pipeline – (2010 – 2012)**

Mahinda Chintana Ten Year Development Framework (2006 – 2016) aims at elevating Sri Lanka to a middle - income country through increasing the per-capita income to the level of US\$ 3,960 by 2016. In this exercise, it has been planned to achieve 8% annual growth rate in Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at constant prices. All three major economic sectors namely, Agriculture, Industry and Services are expected to grow at faster level throughout the planned period, in order to achieve the expected growth rate. The targeted ranges of sectoral growth rates for Agriculture, Industry and Services were 4% - 5%, 8 – 9% and 9 – 10% respectively. In addition, reducing regional disparities in development and poverty incidence is given due consideration in the development framework, while adhering to achieving the targets set out under Millennium Development Goals.

The Project Pipeline contains major project proposals that have been identified by the Government to implement the next three year period, with the assistance of foreign development partners. Implementation of these projects within the targeted period will provide the necessary impetus in the achievement of growth rates and other objectives specified in the Ten Year Development Framework. The majority of the project proposals are related to infrastructure development mainly roads, electricity, power, ports and water supply and sanitation. The accelerated development programmes to be launched in the Northern and Eastern Provinces have been given high priority in designing the project proposals. The sector-wise investments in the Project Pipeline are summarised below.
